



**Keep Madison County Beautiful Poster Contest  
Theme: "What can we recycle?"**

*[note: this contest has already concluded – contest rules are here for information only.]*

Second Grade students will create a poster showing the different things that can be recycled. In our area, these include: plastic (numbers 1 and 2), paper, cardboard, and metal. For 2008, 2<sup>nd</sup> graders during the Spring Semester at Madison County schools will be participants.

KMCB will provide 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teachers in Madison County with a movie and hand-outs will include a listing of area recycling centers the children can take home to their parents. Keep Madison County Beautiful will give a talk about recycling to the second grade classes at the start of the contest.

The entries need to be created with bright colors using a landscape format. 11" X 8 ½"

We need a parental signature with a yes or no about whether or not we can publish their child's name on the calendar.

KMCB judges will then select twelve entries to be published in a calendar by Keep Madison County Beautiful.

Winning entries will be scanned for use on a calendar for 2009 that will be produced as a fund-raiser for KMCB for the Texas Mushroom Festival – 2008.

Judging of the posters will take place May 5, 2008, and will be carried out by three members of the KMCB board of directors.

Winning entries will be scanned, and all will be returned to the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teachers in Madison County to be laminated and put on display at the school.

KMCB will display the laminated posters again at the Texas Mushroom Festival at our Green Team booth on October 25, 2008. After that event, the posters will be returned to the children.
